

# Smith Rock State Park, Oregon



Located along the Crooked River in Central Oregon, the park is popular with rock climbers. Two Phoenix composting toilet systems and evaporators provide an odorless, zero-discharge comfort station for the park's many guests. A photovoltaic array built into the roof provides power.

Prefabricated in ACS's climate controlled factory in Whitefish, MT, the building's sections were hauled to the site on ATVs and reassembled in a matter of days, thus reducing disruption and on-site environmental impacts.

A fierce wildfire stormed through the tinder-dry park in 1996, but the cement-sided Phoenix facility escaped unscathed.
